Congress Site

The venue will be held in Paphos which is one of the most historical cities in the Republic of Cyprus. Paphos, with its picturesque harbour and medieval fort, combines a cosmopolitan holiday resort, spectacular countryside and impressive historical sites. The region offers the possibility of enjoying both sea and mountains, as well as getting a taste of the island's culture with its many archaeological sites.
