This document is the Final Report, which is the deliverable of Stage 4 of the Information Systems Strategy Study of the MOH.

- The management and organisational framework within which the Ministry of Health can develop and operate Information Systems to support its own business needs.

The objectives of the study were:

- To establish the current situation.

- To define the scope and initial Business Case of further computerisation.

- To define the priorities and prepare a catalogue of prioritised Information System and IT infrastructure projects so as to provide a sound basis for subsequent authorisation of those projects.
- To develop an Outline Plan for the deployment of Health Information Technology within the Ministry of Health.
- To identify any procedural and/or organisational issues associated with the implementation of the proposed IT projects.
